OUR LADY OF SION SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Our Lady of Sion School has its own distinctive uniform. There are good reasons for this, the most important being that a uniform helps to create a sense of community and establish a working environment.

Regulation uniform must be worn at all times. Summer uniform may be worn during the first half of the autumn term and throughout the summer term in the Junior School.

Lost uniform which is not labelled will be donated to the Friends' Parents' Association.

Copies of the Junior School and Senior School Uniform lists are included in this policy.

All items of uniform **must** be clearly marked with the owner's name.

Regulation school bags, PE bags and overalls may be obtained from the office (Junior School only).

Students may wear one pair of stud earrings placed low on the earlobes. These must be taped during PE lessons. No other visible body piercings are permitted. Visible tattoos are not allowed.

Senior School pupils may wear one discreet neck chain and one discreet ring. Bracelets are not permitted. Heavy chains, whether worn round the neck or on the belt, are not permitted (this includes padlock/key chains).

Pupils should not wear obvious make-up or coloured nail varnish. Sometimes a light foundation helps young people to feel more confident if they are self-conscious about acne in the teenage years. Please liaise with the School if this is being explored at home.

This uniform policy applies equally to all pupils, however the School will consider reasonable requests to alter the School uniform, for example for genuine religious requirements and reasonable adjustments for children with individual needs or requirements. Where there is uncertainty as to whether an item may be worn, the issue should be referred to the Headteacher, whose decision will be final. Such decisions will be made subject to considerations of safety and welfare and the principles of this policy.

All uniform must be labelled. PE/Games Uniform must be labelled and kept in a named PE bag. The PE kit can be personalised by our uniform supplier at a small cost. This is optional.

If individual students would like to discuss the uniform, they should meet with the Headteacher in the first instance, along with their parents.

Uniform and Appearance

- i. The school uniform should be worn properly and completely in accordance with the uniform list. All students are expected to look clean and tidy at all times. Sanctions will be applied where students fail to observe this rule. The same requirements apply to PE kit. Sixth Form students should not wear extremes of fashion, hairstyles or make-up.
- ii. All items of uniform, including PE kit, must be clearly labelled with the student's name. The PE kit can be personalised with your child's initials (optional). There will be a small charge. Please speak to our uniform supplier, Broadwater Sports. Students must not borrow items of uniform from each other.
- iii. Hair should be clean and tidy. Acceptable hairstyles exclude part or full-shaven heads, obvious colourant in unnatural shades and/or any other extreme trends. Gel, wax, styling mousse or similar products must be used with discretion and not used to create extremes of fashion. Holiday styles and/or colour must be rationalised <u>before</u> students return to School. Students with long hair must wear it tied or clipped back when instructed for health and safety reasons.
- iv. Students may not wear obvious make-up or coloured nail polish.
- v. We accept one pair of stud earrings placed low on the earlobes. These must be taped during PE Lessons. No other visible body piercings are permitted. Visible tattoos are not allowed.
- vi. Senior School pupils may wear one discreet neck chain and one discreet ring. Bracelets are not permitted. Heavy chains, whether worn round the neck or on the belt, are not permitted (this includes padlock/key chains).
- vii. This uniform policy applies equally to all pupils, however the School will consider reasonable requests to alter the School uniform, for example for genuine religious requirements and reasonable adjustments for children with individual needs or requirements. Black shoes (polishable) – not branded (Nike, Vans, etc)

Plain grey or black socks - not branded (Adidas, Nike, etc)

Mid-grey trousers (<u>not</u> black). These should be classic in design. Not skinny or too fitted and without extra pockets or zips.

White shirts (short or long-sleeved)

School tie (obtainable from the School Office)

White full length Science overall with sleeves

Black shoes (sensible shoes which are polishable) – not branded

Plain grey socks or grey/black tights (winter) – not branded

White socks or flesh coloured tights (summer)

White long-sleeved revere collar (winter). Worn with House badge.

Notes:

- (1) Students must wear mouth guards for all contact sports
- (2) Only trainer type soled shoes are to be used on the Astroturf, ie, no spikes, no blades, no metal studs
- (3) Broadwater Sports are able to personalise your child's PE kit with their initials at a small charge

When PE is timetabled, students should arrive in their PE kit and remain in this kit for the whole day. Students are expected to arrive at school wearing their student leggings or tracksuit trousers on PE days.

SIXTH FORM

Sixth Form Students are not required to wear school uniform but we do ask that students dress appropriately for a professional working environment and as representatives of the School.

- Shirts should be smart and jeans must not be faded, ripped or have holes.
- Shorts may be worn, however should be tailored. Shorts, skirts and dresses should be at least midthigh length. Tracksuit bottoms/leggings may not be worn.
- Appropriate sports clothing may be worn on Wednesdays for those taking part in games lessons.
- Extremes of fashion or appearance, including beach wear, party wear, visible tattoos or body piercings (with the exception of earrings, small stud or rings) are not permitted.
- **Formal Uniform** there may be times where a smarter dress code would be more appropriate, for example awards evenings, open days or if you are doing a tour of the school in which the following dress code should apply:
- A collared shirt (and tie if appropriate) and either skirt or trousers or a dress.
- Smart shoes required (heels may be worn but must be no higher than 2 inches). No trainers.
- A formal jacket or blazer.
- No jeans or hooded jumpers.

Pre-Loved Uniform

The School stocks pre-loved whole school uniform and encourages families to explore this stock, which is found in the Admissions Centre (Senior School) and also in the Junior School.
